- To support this commitment the Group has set the following targets.
  - 1. All business units to be ISO 45001 certified by 2028.
  - 2. Accident frequency and severity rates to be below the manufacturing industry average.
  - 3. Absenteeism rates to be below the manufacturing industry average.
  - 4. All employees to have access to assistance and wellness programs by 2026.

- The Group will publicly report progress on our objectives annually on the Group website.
